

Minister of Basic and Senior Secondary Education Hon. Alpha Timbo continues dialogue with Teachers.

The Minister of Basic and Senior Secondary Education Hon. Alpha Timbo is currently on a nation-wide tour to dialogue with teachers at District level on issues of their conditions of service.

Just as he advised Concerned Teachers in Kenema District, the minister admonished the Voice of Teachers in Tonkolili and Bombali District to stop making statements and comparisons which people might misunderstand to be of hatred.
