

MINISTRY OF BASIC AND SENIOR SECONDARY EDUCATION PARTNERS WITH UNICEF TO ANALYZE MICS-EAGLE EDUCATION DATA

The general overview of this workshop is that UNICEF's MICS-Education Analysis for Global Learning and Equity or MICS-EAGLE in collaboration with the Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education wants stakeholders of the Free Quality School Education to discuss and further analyse the MICS-EAGLE key findings, priority issues, critical barriers and Sectoral actions that are based on the MICS6 education data.

Key objectives of the workshop include supporting the Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education by initiating evidence-based policy analysis, review education data focused on equity, identifying needs, producing results that could be incorporated into the MICS-EAGLE country report, and improving the capacity of education stakeholders.

MICS-EAGLE is a UNICEF's global initiative providing systematic in-depth data analysis that supports government for evidence-based policy planning, monitoring and advocacy. Participants at this education stakeholder's workshop include officials from the Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education, Statistics Sierra Leone, government research functions, WASH and child protection agencies, development partners, civil society organizations including NGOs, and UNICEF.
